Should you wish for your horse to stop over at Blidworth on a re-habilitation programme, please talk to Kate.

Please also be aware that this treatment is an alternative treatment which is recognised by many insurance companies, therefore, if your horse is referred by a veterinary practitioner or registered farrier many insurance companies will pay the hydrotherapy treatment, but again, please check your insurance policy.
